Animal Humane Society: (952-435-7738)

One of the biggest in Minnesota.

- Adoption, lost & found services, medical care
 - Behavior help + community support programs
 - Locations in the Twin Cities, Golden Valley, Coon Rapids, and St. Paul area
 - Very helpful for transfers and urgent intake cases
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Feline Rescue Inc: (612-900-2757)

- Cat-only rescue in St. Paul
 - Focus on stray, abused, and feral-to-friendly rehabilitation
 - Strong medical + socialization program
 - All volunteer-based
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Ruff Start Rescue: (763-355-3981)

- Very active statewide foster network
 - Works with cats from rural MN (very relevant to your area)
 - Provides vet care, fosters, and adoption support
 - Good option for transferring cats or finding fosters
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Pet Haven of Minnesota: (952-831-3825)

- One of the oldest foster-based rescues in MN
 - Specializes in medical cases and hard-to-place cats
 - Strong foster network in metro area
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Kitty Revolution: (612-351-1025)

- Foster-based rescue in Inver Grove Heights area
 - Focuses on cats that are often overlooked (shy, medical, behavior cases)
 - Often partners with animal control intake situations
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The Rescue Crew: (612-299-2001)

- Volunteer-run, foster-based
 - Takes urgent shelter transfers (including cats from animal control systems)
 - Good “emergency placement” contact rescue
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TNR / feral & colony support (VERY important in MN)

Pet Project Rescue: (612-217-4738)

- Free or low-cost TNR across Minnesota
 - Spay/neuter + vaccination support
 - Helps caretakers manage colonies humanely
 - Strong match for rural farm cat situations
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Furball Farm Cat Sanctuary: (612-298-7634)

- Sanctuary for feral and semi-feral cats
 - Provides spay/neuter support for farm/colony cats
 - Also helps stabilize unmanaged colonies in rural MN
 - Useful model + potential partner for outreach
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Low-cost vet & cat medical support (central MN relevant)

- Includes spay/neuter, vaccines, ear tipping
- Designed specifically for feral/community cats
- Extremely relevant for farm colonies

Minnesota Spay Neuter Assistance Program (MNSNAP): (612-720-8236)

- Low-cost sterilization for cats and dogs
- Often partners with shelters and rescues
- Helps reduce overpopulation long-term
